

Jupiter in Gemini

The sign that Jupiter occupies shows the language you speak to grow and to experience faith. The element of the sign is the dominant language and gives specific guidance about how and why you grow and how and why you build faith. The sign itself is a dialect of that language and provides additional, more specific information about how you grow, expand your consciousness, and experience faith.

JOURNAL QUESTIONS & INSTRUCTIONS

Read the descriptions below, and then go back and revisit each of the earlier journal questions. Review your answers, and then expand on them, incorporating the new information about the language you speak. Focus on how and why you express Jupiter.

Jupiter in Air Signs

With Jupiter in an Air sign, you grow and expand on the mental and intellectual plane. Growth is conscious, impersonal, objective, and external, and always begins as a thought form. You seek out ideas and abstract concepts, and you engage with them objectively and impersonally. You are most interested in exploring all that exists in your current reality and your current level of consciousness.

You have faith in facts and data, and things that can be verified objectively. Your faith only extends to the surface, and that which is known and can be viewed in the light. You have an inherent distrust of things that are hidden or that operate beneath the surface. Most notably, you lack faith in feelings and emotions. Because they are internal and subjective, feelings are inherently suspect. Faith is objective, sequential, conscious and abstract. It requires some kind of logical, reasonable foundation.

Jupiter in Gemini


Jupiter in Gemini experiences “little r” reality through the context of a microscope. Rather than seeing the whole, he experiences each individual component, moving quickly from one to the next. He assimilates glimpses and impressions of each experience, adding each new

piece of information to an ever-growing database. As this web of experiences and impressions grows, Jupiter in Gemini creates an expanded context. By considering the relationships, he comprehends a whole that is significantly greater than the sum of the parts. Jupiter in Gemini has faith in the intellect, and in the ineffable connection of all things. The challenge for Jupiter in Gemini is to avoid confusing innocence with ignorance. When confronted with the vastness of what is not yet known, Jupiter in Gemini can experience Shame. To avoid this pain, he may step into “God’s Business,” and become trapped at the level of pride, knowing *about* everything, but *knowing* nothing.

When you are in Right Relationship with Jupiter in Gemini, you appreciate that you have an unusual approach to experiencing your “little r” reality. Other people see the forest, but sometimes you don’t even see the trees because you’re too busy noticing the details of an individual leaf. You understand the holographic nature of your “little r” reality. All of creation is contained within the smallest detail. When you need to see the forest, you can, of course. But you recognize the gift of your approach. Because you experience each detail independent of its original context, you are not limited by the gravitational pull of that context. Other people process information in a linear, two-dimensional fashion, but you are able to think in three dimensions. You are able to discover elegant, “out of the box” solutions to problems that are intractable to others. The more trivial data you absorb, the more intricate and complex your web of connections becomes. You are able to look beyond what is real, and discover what is true. The content reveals the context. You have absolute faith in the ultimate context that is the “Big R” Reality.

When you are out of alignment with Jupiter in Gemini, you are unable to see the forest for the trees; you’re not even able to see the trees for the leaves. What’s more, you are fully aware of this, and spend a considerable amount of time and energy worrying about it. Your awareness does not change your behavior, however. In the absence of a connection to your “Big S” Self, your “little s” self obsessively collects information, believing that knowledge is the same thing as Wisdom. You have faith in the power of your intellect and the linear mind, but as powerful as reason and logic are, they still represent limited context. You can only grow so far before you identify with what is real rather than with what is true. You believe that if you gather enough data, you will eventually experience a quantum leap in understanding. What you don’t realize is that understanding requires a greater context, not more content. Content without context is worthless. Your interests are so varied that you find it impossible to explore any of them with any degree of thoroughness. You know *about* a great many things, but you *know* very little. You worry about this, but only sporadically, because your addiction to gathering new information takes over, and you become temporarily consumed with acquiring a new bit of trivia.
