

# Jupiter in Virgo

**T**he sign that Jupiter occupies shows the language you speak to grow and to experience faith. The element of the sign is the dominant language and gives specific guidance about how and why you grow and how and why you build faith. The sign itself is a dialect of that language and provides additional, more specific information about how you grow, expand your consciousness, and experience faith.

## Jupiter in Earth Signs

With Jupiter in an Earth Sign, you grow and expand on the physical and material plane. You are concerned with the essential reality of things, and you pursue a concrete, unconscious, impersonal, and objective understanding. These internal references provide the building blocks of your expansion and create a solid foundation on which you can build. But growth is always tangible and concrete. You are neither comfortable nor satisfied with abstract, theoretical progress.

Faith is also a challenging concept for you because you reject that which is too personal, subjective, or superficial and external. Your faith is not ephemeral; it is built out of bedrock, and it has been tested and verified so thoroughly that it seems obvious and self-evident. Other people may not be able to recognize or appreciate the essential, objective reality that forms your faith, but it's so obvious, logical, and concrete to you, that questioning its existence is unthinkable.

## Jupiter in Virgo

Jupiter in Virgo approaches each experience with an analytical filter, separating the wheat from the chaff and seeking the core, divine essence within. By differentiating between what is *real*



and what is *true*, Jupiter in Virgo uncovers the perfection of the Divine in all things. God is truly in the details for Jupiter in Virgo. He has faith that everything in form is absolutely perfect, and knows that perfection, like creation, is an ongoing process. Everything that exists is a perfect expression of its true nature. The challenge for Jupiter in Virgo is to avoid creating attachments to the world of form. This can trap Jupiter in Virgo at the consciousness of fear, which can undermine his faith.

When you are in Right Relationship with Jupiter in Virgo, you embody the perfect balance between faith and action, and between spirit and form. You have faith in God as your source, and that all creation occurs through the Law of Attraction. You seek perfection in all things, and you apply your considerable analytical and observational powers to your “little r” reality in order to identify any and all flaws. You know that any imperfections in form are the result of imperfections in your thoughts and your “little s” story. What exists in form is a perfect manifestation of your level of consciousness. Instead of attempting to improve what has already been created, you focus your attention on improving and expanding your consciousness. You build your faith each time you turn away from what is real and focus on what is true. You know that each flaw and imperfection you discover in form represents a part of your story where you are operating from Victim Consciousness. You analyze your story, questioning your beliefs to discover the places where you lack faith in the Universe and have created attachments to the world of form. You dissolve these attachments with compassion and faith, knowing that the truth will manifest perfectly in your “little r” reality.

When you are out of alignment with Jupiter in Virgo, you worry because you believe you lack faith. You see how much comfort faith brings to others, and you are eager to experience faith yourself—just as soon as you have some proof to back it up. The problem is that you lack a connection to your “Big S” Self, and instead you rely on your “little s” self to navigate your “little r” reality. The “little s” self is limited to the context of the linear mind, and is not capable of experiencing faith. All the “little s” self has is belief. Faith is confirmable, but not provable, and this is what the “little s” self is unable to appreciate. Because of your need for proof, you create profound attachments to the world of form. You rely exclusively on numbers, figures and details, and these prove without a doubt that the world is filled with lack. Even so, you long to build your faith. With great effort, you set aside your attachments and ask the Universe for support. You prepare to take a leap of faith, but before you are able to, the balance in your Safety Need Account drops below the critical level, and you retreat to the familiar comforts of what you believe to be real. This slowly erodes what faith you have, and reaffirms your belief that the source of your happiness is in the outside world. You are driven to fix, improve and perfect everything in your “little r” reality, and may even become prone to obsessive and compulsive behavior.
