

Jupiter in Sagittarius

The sign that Jupiter occupies shows the language you speak to grow and to experience faith. The element of the sign is the dominant language and gives specific guidance about how and why you grow and how and why you build faith. The sign itself is a dialect of that language and provides additional, more specific information about how you grow, expand your consciousness, and experience faith.

Read the descriptions below, and then go back and revisit each of the earlier journal questions. Review your answers, and then expand on them, incorporating the new information about the language you speak. Focus on how and why you express Jupiter.

Jupiter in Fire Signs

With Jupiter in a Fire sign, you grow and expand through direct experience and living in the moment. Growth is conscious, personal, subjective, abstract, and inspired. The element of Fire represents the breath and the spark of life, and planets in Fire signs are inspired to express by expending energy. So long as you have energy and fuel available, you will push past boundaries and seek out new territory. You are powerfully motivated to seek out the highest expressions of truth.

You build faith through direct experience. And even though faith can be somewhat abstract and difficult to describe, your faith is something that lives within you. It doesn't matter if others share your faith or believe what you believe; your faith is a rock, and you use your faith to grow, expand, and seek out a broader connection to the truth. Your faith is subjective and personal, and based on external truth.

Jupiter in Sagittarius

Jupiter in Sagittarius embraces each new experience, idea and philosophy with his whole being and a profound leap of faith. This is the only way that he knows how to test for truth. He will assimilate that which resonates as true, and discard everything else. Jupiter in Sagittarius has absolute faith in the truth, and knows that discovering and knowing the truth will bring

about freedom. Each new experience for Jupiter in Sagittarius is a revelation: it opens the mind, broadens the horizons, expands the context, and creates more room for the truth. Pride is the most dangerous trap for Jupiter in Sagittarius. It's tempting to assume that what is true for you must be true for everyone.

When you are in Right Relationship with Jupiter in Sagittarius, you are open to new experiences, and hunger for new ideas, opinions, theories and philosophies. You appreciate that your understanding of truth is always evolving and expanding. Your quest is to augment your personal truth so that it more fully resembles the ultimate truth. Because you maintain a powerful connection to your "Big S" Self, you are willing to question everything—even (and especially) the beliefs that you hold to be the most sacred. You know that the ultimate truth is eternal, unshakable, and beyond all form and appearance. The only way to verify your connection to it is to test your faith. You seek out different opinions and beliefs and enjoy passionate, intelligent debate with others. You can engage in these debates because you are free from the limiting belief that in order for one person to be right, the other person must be wrong. You know that the truth is infinite, and therefore it must include everything. When you encounter a belief or perspective that seems to contradict what you know to be true for you, you expand your consciousness. When you experience your "little r" reality from a sufficiently large context, you transcend and resolve the apparent conflict, discovering how both approaches are contained within the larger truth.

When you are out of alignment with Jupiter in Sagittarius, you have an abundance of belief; what you lack is faith. Belief is what the ego/body and the "little s" self has. Faith can only be experienced through a connection with the "Big S" Self. Without the larger context of faith, you have only a narrow, limited understanding of truth. Your "little s" self equates being wrong with death, so you become invested in the belief that you are right, and you are aligned with the only truth. You lack the ability to question your beliefs; truth for you is dogma. The fact that other people have different opinions about truth is unbearable because it means that you could be wrong. Rather than expanding your context to allow for a greater appreciation of truth, you try to make the rest of your "little r" reality conform to your perception of truth. You argue, debate, harangue, and proselytize, attempting to convert others to your beliefs. If you are unsuccessful, you will leave, and surround yourself with others who share and reinforce your beliefs. You are convinced that your beliefs make you strong and help you to grow, when in fact, they trap and limit you, keeping you small. Your beliefs bring you neither joy, nor peace, nor freedom, because you lack the faith to surrender what is real and encounter what is true.
