

Jupiter in Capricorn

The sign that Jupiter occupies shows the language you speak to grow and to experience faith. The element of the sign is the dominant language and gives specific guidance about how and why you grow and how and why you build faith. The sign itself is a dialect of that language and provides additional, more specific information about how you grow, expand your consciousness, and experience faith.

Jupiter in Earth Signs

With Jupiter in an Earth Sign, you grow and expand on the physical and material plane. You are concerned with the essential reality of things, and you pursue a concrete, unconscious, impersonal, and objective understanding. These internal references provide the building blocks of your expansion and create a solid foundation on which you can build. But growth is always tangible and concrete. You are neither comfortable nor satisfied with abstract, theoretical progress.

Faith is also a challenging concept for you because you reject that which is too personal, subjective, or superficial and external. Your faith is not ephemeral; it is built out of bedrock, and it has been tested and verified so thoroughly that it seems obvious and self-evident. Other people may not be able to recognize or appreciate the essential, objective reality that forms your faith, but it's so obvious, logical, and concrete to you, that questioning its existence is unthinkable.

Jupiter in Capricorn

For Jupiter in Capricorn, the value of each experience is based on how it supports and expands your individual identity and how it allows you to contribute to society. What Jupiter in



Capricorn looks for are the practical applications of each experience. The context for Jupiter in Capricorn is the material world; mastery over the world of form indicates mastery of Spirit, as well. Jupiter in Capricorn has faith in the rules, the structures and the Universal Laws, both those that directly influence the world of form such as the Law of Cause and Effect, and those that indirectly influence it such as the Law of Attraction. The biggest challenge for Jupiter in Capricorn is to avoid creating attachments to the physical world. The more success you manifest, the greater the vulnerability to the fear of loss.

When you are in Right Relationship with Jupiter in Capricorn, you enjoy tremendous prosperity, abundance and success without creating any attachments to the world of form. To the casual observer, your success appears to be the result of hard work and focused, responsible effort; in truth, however, your success is the result of your faith and dedication to spiritual law. Your connection to your “Big S” Self allows you to see past what is real—no matter how enticing it may be—and stay aligned with what is true. Everything that you manifest in your “little r” reality is simply the tangible expression of your consciousness. You direct all of your attention to embodying your Core Values and your Personal Standards of Integrity. Success and prosperity are pleasant side effects of the vibration of your thoughts. You have faith that abundance is the nature of the Universe, and this truth manifests in your “little r” reality. You absolutely know that the source of your happiness is within you, and has nothing to do with anything in form. The main reason that you even notice the world of form is that it helps you to track and measure your consciousness. As long as you continue to experience prosperity, success, and expansion, you know that you are aligned with the truth.

When you are out of alignment with Jupiter in Capricorn, you are trapped by the illusions and appearance of form. What you perceive as real is so real that you are unable to accept that it is not true. It’s inconceivable to you that abundance is the nature of the Universe, because all you experience is profound lack. Your “little s” self believes that the only way to expand is to acquire more—more money, more status, more success, and more recognition. You become addicted to reaching your goals, whatever they may be, and yet, no matter how much you have, it is never enough. You hoard your acquisitions, driven by desire to acquire even more, and paralyzed by the fear that you might lose what you have won. You are never able to enjoy the fruits of your considerable labors, and they never bring you happiness. Your entire sense of self becomes entangled in your accomplishments; however, your accomplishments have no connection to your Core Values or your Personal Standards of Integrity. As a result, no matter what you accomplish, you still feel small and inadequate. This consciousness of lack persists whether you struggle with day-to-day subsistence, or you manifest significant material resources. Because you put your faith in the world of form and believe that your source is outside of you, no matter how much you have, it will never be enough.
